

BUILD A HOME COMPOSTER CHALLENGE

Introduction:

Create a backyard composter that could divert most if not all of your vegetable food waste from the landfill. This is a project in three stages. (1) Identify food waste in your household that could be easily diverted. (2) Create a container/space inside your house easily accessible to you food preparation area, where your vegetable waste can be stored short term before moving to your main composter. (3) Identify a space and gather materials for your outside composter area.

Challenge:

Challenge is to divert a percentage of your household waste to your new compost bin.

Objective:

Build an outdoor composting area for vegetable waste composting

Tools:

You will need your parents' help with this. Also common gardening tools (shovel, rake) some waste wood materials (old pallets, wooden packaging. waste wood ends). Screws and drill/driver.

Prep:

Select a piece of ground in your backyard that could host your composting area. Find some waste materials that you could use to start setting up the space
